Easy steps to make a Cord Rosary.

Materials: No. 9 nylon cord, available in either 4 lb. or 1 lb. tubes, white only. Plastic cruciffons or base metal cruciffons, plastic beads (60 needed for each Resary), and tool for making lend. These supplies may be purchased from the Resery Malera.

You will also need a pair of very sharp scissors and, we recommend, a bodie of clear nail polish or a jar of clear shellac with which to dip or brush the ends of the cord to make them stiff to easily go through the beads. This also eliminates any raveled ends.

Procedure: Use 60 inches of cord. Mark one end of cord as 8 inches for starting position. Dip or brush ends of cord with nail polish or clear shellar, if desired. Bonded cord gives the least chance of raveling, and you may decide there is no need to cost ends.

Make first knot at 8 inch starting position. Read instructions which follow and then refer to STEP 1 below. It is important to kneep this 8 inches free on end. Place tool in left hand foreverse all instructions for left-handed person and hold in a horizontal position as shown. Let the you cod over grooved end of nool with grooved side locing towards you. Left thumb holds cord against the tool as right hand wraps cord around beds of tool and brings it in front and crosses over the cord held by the left thumb to form an X. Remember this X is at the 8 inch starting position. Keep X in centur of tool. With right hand, wrap two more loops around viol, on next to the other, wedding from right to left towards the handle of the tool. To secure lenot, hold the loops with the left index finger.
