Prayer Blanket/ Prayer Shawl Ministry

What is a Prayer Blanket or Prayer Shawl? These are small lap blankets that are sewn, knitted, or crocheted by group members and prayed over by the maker during construction. Once completed, they are then blessed by the priest or a deacon before being given away. These prayer blankets/shawls are meant to bring comfort, a sense of peace, and love to the recipient, and to let them know we are praying for them.

Who is eligible to receive a blanket or shawl? Adults or

children with physical or emotional illness, living with a chronic condition or in treatment for a life-threatening illness, those experiencing a crisis such as the loss of a loved one, loss of job, or relationship crisis.
