- Social - celebrate with us at the various events and activities we sponsor throughout the year.

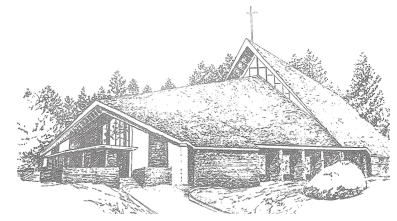

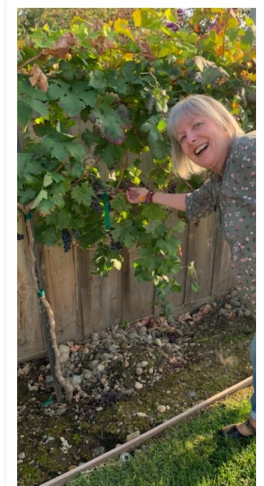

## SPIRITUAL

Plans include guest speakers, offsite retreats, Mass, and an annual Advent By Candlelight event hosted by STM Women. Past events include the group traveling together to attend a special Mass in Red Bluff.



## MEETINGS
