MEDITATION OF THE DAY

"Let your 'yes' be 'yes'"

Love denotes an act of fundamental assent to another, a "yes" to the person towards whom the love is directed: "It is good that you exist" is Josef Pieper's striking definition of the nature of love. The lover discovers the goodness of being in this person, is happy because of his or her existence, says "yes" to this existence and confirms it. Even before any thought of self, before any desire or wish, there stands the simple business of being happy at the existence of the beloved, the "yes" to this "you." It is only in a second moment (not of time but of fact) that the lover discovers that in this way, because your existence is good, my own existence too has become better, more precious, happier. By saying "yes" to another, to "you," I receive myself made new and can now in a new way say "yes" to myself, thanks to you....

We can also understand a little better that God's second "yes" that was made manifest on the cross is our rebirth and that it is only this rebirth that finally and definitively makes us alive. And lastly the awareness can dawn that as people who have been affirmed by God in this way we are called to share in his "yes." We have been asked to continue his creation, to be co-creators, by giving being to the other in a new way in the affirmation of love—letting the gift of love now really become a gift.

Ojalá disfrutes tomándote el tiempo de rezar esta hermosa oración que rinde homenaje al amor excesivo del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús con el que tanto nos ama.



Dulcísimo Jesús, cuya desbordante caridad para con los hombres es correspondida con tanto olvido, negligencia y desprecio, míranos postrados ante Ti, deseosos de reparar con un acto especial de homenaje las crueles indiferencias y agravios a que está sujeto en todas partes tu amoroso Corazón.

¡Consciente, ay! que nosotros mismos hemos participado en tan grandes indignidades, que ahora deploramos desde lo más profundo de nuestro corazón, humildemente te pedimos perdón y declaramos que estamos dispuestos a expiar mediante la expiación voluntaria, no sólo por nuestras ofensas personales, sino también por las pecados de aquellos que, desviándose del camino de la salvación, se niegan en su obstinada infidelidad a seguirte a Ti, su Pastor y Guía, o, renunciando a las promesas de su bautismo, se han despojado del dulce yugo de tu ley.

Ahora estamos resueltos a expiar todos y cada uno de los deplorables ultrajes cometidos contra Ti; Ahora estamos decididos a enmendar las múltiples ofensas contra la modestia cristiana en cuanto a vestimenta y comportamiento impropios, por todas las sucias seducciones tendidas para atrapar los pies de los inocentes, por las frecuentes violaciones de los domingos y días santos, y las espantosas blasfemias pronunciadas contra Tú y tus santos.

Deseamos también reparar los insultos a los que son sometidos Tu Vicario en la tierra y Tus sacerdotes, por la profanación, por negligencia consciente o terribles actos de sacrilegio, del mismo Sacramento de Tu Divino Amor; y finalmente por los crímenes públicos de las naciones que resisten los derechos y la autoridad docente de la Iglesia que Tú has fundado.

Ojalá pudiéramos lavar tales abominaciones con nuestra sangre. Ofrecemos ahora, en reparación por estas violaciones de Tu divino honor, la satisfacción que una vez le diste a Tu Padre Eterno en la Cruz y que continúas renovando diariamente en nuestros Altares; lo ofrecemos en unión con los actos de expiación de Tu Virgen Madre y de todos los Santos y de los piadosos fieles de la tierra; y prometemos sinceramente recompensar, en la medida de lo posible, con la ayuda de Tu gracia, por todo descuido de Tu gran amor y por los pecados que nosotros y otros hemos cometido en el pasado. De ahora en adelante viviremos una vida de fe inquebrantable, de pureza de conducta, de perfecta observancia de los preceptos del Evangelio y especialmente de la caridad. Prometemos hacer lo mejor que podamos para evitar que otros te ofendan y hacer que tantos como sea posible te sigan.

Hopefully you will enjoy taking the time to pray this beautiful prayer which gives homage to the excessive love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus with which He so loves us.

Most sweet Jesus, whose overflowing charity for men is requited by so much forgetfulness, negligence & contempt, behold us prostrate before Thee, eager to repair by a special act of homage the cruel indifference and injuries to which Thy loving Heart is everywhere subject.

Mindful, alas! that we ourselves have had a share in such great indignities, which we now deplore from the depths of our hearts, we humbly ask Thy pardon & declare our readiness to atone by voluntary expiation, not only for our own personal offenses, but also for the sins of those, who, straying far from the path of salvation, refuse in their obstinate infidelity to follow Thee, their Shepherd and Leader, or, renouncing the promises of their baptism, have cast off the sweet yoke of Thy law.

We are now resolved to expiate each & every deplorable outrage committed against Thee; we are now determined to make amends for the manifold offenses against Christian modesty in unbecoming dress and behavior, for all the foul seductions laid to ensnare the feet of the innocent, for the frequent violations of Sundays and holy days, and the shocking blasphemies uttered against Thee and Thy Saints.

We wish also to make amends for the insults to which Thy Vicar on earth & Thy priests are subjected, for the profanation, by conscious neglect or terrible acts of sacrilege, of the very Sacrament of Thy Divine Love; and lastly for the public crimes of nations who resist the rights and teaching authority of the Church which Thou hast founded.

Would that we were able to wash away such abominations with our blood. We now offer, in reparation for these violations of Thy divine honor, the satisfaction Thou once made to Thy Eternal Father on the Cross and which Thou continues to renew daily on our Altars; we offer it in union with the acts of atonement of Thy Virgin Mother & all the Saints and of the pious faithful on earth; and we sincerely promise to make recompense, as far as we can with the help of Thy grace, for all neglect of Thy great love & for the sins we & others have committed in the past. Henceforth, we will live a life of unwavering faith, of purity of conduct, of perfect observance of the precepts of the Gospel and especially that of charity. We promise to the best of our power to prevent others from offending Thee and to bring as many as possible to follow Thee.
