Knowing and Loving the Trinity

After having spoken many times & in various ways to our Fathers through the Prophets, God, in these last days, spoke to us through his Son, the Word, who bears the stamp of his substance and the splendor of his glory (Heb 1:1-3), who came to earth to preach to men the kingdom of God and to tell them about the secret and hidden life of the Triune God. [The Old Testament Prophets] had emphasized certain attributes of God:

Isaiah spoke of his greatness and majesty, Jeremiah of his justice, and Hosea of his merciful love and unflagging tenacity. And the greatest of them all, Moses, had risen all the way to the sublime truth that touches intimately the mystery of God's ineffable being: I am he who is (Ex 3:14).

But no one has ever seen God. Only God, the only Son who is in the bosom of the Father, could come and reveal him to us (cf. Jn 1:18). He has manifested to men the authentic divine Reality: God the Father; God the Son, equal to the Father and one with him; God the Holy Spirit, proceeding from the Father and the Son.... The Incarnation of the Word inaugurates a new age, one that is explicitly Trinitarian; a new creed, in a God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; a new economy, with new worship, a new priesthood, a new people, a new kingship characteristic of what we can call, with Saint Ambrose, "the royal kingdom of the Trinity," regnum Trinitatis. The mystery of the Trinity, which remained in the shadows throughout the Old Testament, bursts into light in the New.... The Church of Christ will forever be illuminated by this triune mystery....


St. John is the one who has presented to us the simple & sublime words in which the Lord himself has summarized our entire spiritual life as being such a permanent intimacy with God. If anyone loves me, he will keep my word and my Father will love him and we will come to him and make our dwelling in him (Jn 14:23). The Spirit of Love, the Paraclete, will also dwell in you (cf. Jn 14:16-17). This indwelling of the Trinity in our souls constitutes the essence of our interior life: to live in communion with the Father and the Son, by the breath of the same Spirit of love.


HOMILY NOTES





¡Bienvenidos a junio! Este mes está consagrado a la devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. «De entre todas las pruebas de la infinita bondad de nuestro Salvador, ninguna destaca más que el hecho de que, al enfriarse el amor de los fieles, Él, el Amor Divino mismo, se entregó a nosotros para ser honrado con una devoción muy especial, y que el rico tesoro de la Iglesia se abrió de par en par en beneficio de esa devoción». Estas palabras del Papa Pío XI se refieren a la Devoción al Sagrado Corazón, que en su forma

actual data de las revelaciones dadas a Santa Margarita María Alacoque en 1673-1675.

ORACIÓN AL SAGRADO CORAZÓN

La devoción al Sagrado Corazón fue característica de la piedad en la época de Santa Gertrudis la Grande (1256-1302), monja benedictina y reconocida mística. De hecho, fue la primera gran exponente de la devoción al Sagrado Corazón. En nuestros esfuerzos por honrar el Corazón de Jesús, nosotros [en la Red Mundial de Oración del Papa] tenemos esta oración como modelo para la nuestra:

Señor, hoy vengo a tu tierno Corazón, a ti que tienes palabras que encienden mi corazón, a ti que derramas compasión sobre los pequeños y los pobres, sobre los que sufren y sobre todas las miserias humanas.

Deseo conocerte más, contemplarte en el Evangelio, estar contigo y aprender de ti y de la caridad con la que te dejaste tocar por todas las formas de pobreza.

Nos mostraste el amor del Padre amándonos sin medida con tu Corazón divino y humano. Concede a todos tus hijos la gracia de encontrarte. Cambia, moldea y transforma nuestros planes para que solo te busquemos a ti en cada circunstancia: en la oración, en el trabajo, en los encuentros y en nuestra vida diaria.

Desde este encuentro, envíanos en misión, una misión de compasión por el mundo en la que Tú eres la fuente de donde mana todo consuelo. Amén.

Welcome to June! This month is set apart for devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. "From among all the proofs of the infinite goodness of our Savior none stands out more prominently than the fact that, as the love of the faithful grew cold, He, Divine Love Itself, gave Himself to us to be honored by a very special devotion and that the rich treasury of the Church was thrown wide open in the interests of that devotion." These words of Pope Pius XI refer to the Sacred Heart Devotion, which in

its present form dates from the revelations given to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673-75.

POPE LEO XIV RELEASES HIS 1ST MONTHLY INTENTION

PRAYER TO THE SACRED HEART

Devotion to the Sacred Heart was characteristic of the piety during the time of St. Gertrude the Great (1256-1302), Benedictine nun and renowned mystic. She was, in fact, the first great exponent of devotion to the Sacred Heart. In our efforts to honor the Heart of Jesus we [at the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network] have this prayer as a model for our own:

Lord, I come to Your tender Heart today, to You who have words that set my heart ablaze, to You who pour out compassion on the little ones & the poor, on those who suffer, and on all human miseries.

I desire to know You more, to contemplate You in the Gospel, to be with You and learn from You and from the charity with which You allowed Yourself to be touched by all forms of poverty.

You showed us the Father's love by loving us without measure with Your divine and human Heart.
Grant all Your children the grace of encountering You.
Change, shape, and transform our plans, so that we seek only You in every circumstance: in prayer, in work, in encounters, and in our daily routine.

From this encounter, send us out on mission, a mission of compassion for the world in which You are the source from which all consolation flows. Amen.
